PARKS

Clearview Park: Located in Clearview Subdivision

Eddie Aragon Park: Located between S. Parish Ave. and Castle Pines Ave.

Hays Park: Located in the Country Acres Subdivision on Country Acres Drive and Harding Ave.

Lake Park: Take Hwy 60 to High Plains Blvd. Turn right onto Rocksbury Lane. Lake Park will be straight ahead.

Parish Park: Located at Charlotte St. and Raymond Ave.

Rolling Hills Ranch Park: Located in Rolling Hills Ranch Subdivision on Rolling Hills Parkway.

Pioneer Ridge Park: Located west of Pioneer Ridge Elementary School at the corner of Cinnamon Teal Ave and Saxony Rd.

Sunrise Park: Located at north end of Greeley Ave. Can also be accessed off N. 6th St. near Jay Ave.

PET LICENSING

The Town of Johnstown requires all dogs and cats to be licensed. The fee for neutered or spayed dogs is \$4, and the fee for natural dogs is \$10. You will need to have current proof of rabies license prior to obtaining a dog license. Please call the Town of Johnstown for more information.
