

JOHNSTOWN LAKE Fishing Regulations

Permits:

- The Johnstown Lake is open to the public. However, a Johnstown Fishing Permit is required to fish.
- No fishing will be allowed without a Johnstown Fishing Permit even if the person has a Colorado Fishing License.
- Permits are available for purchase at Town Hall, 450 S Parish Ave, during normal business hours (M-F 8:00-5:00). Permit sales will not take place during the weekend.
- You must bring a valid Colorado Fishing License when purchasing a Johnstown Fishing Permit.

Cost for Johnstown residents is \$5.00 per household

- The permit must include the names of the family members that are covered under the permit.
- Johnstown residents can have guests as long as the guests are fishing with the Johnstown resident who has a permit.

Cost for Non-Johnstown residents: \$25.00 per household

- The permit must include the names of the family members that are covered under the permit.
- Non-residents **cannot** have guests included on their permit. All guests of non-residents must purchase a permit from Town Hall for their own household.

General regulations

- Under the age of 16 a permit is not required.
- 16 years of age or older are required to have a permit. If a permit has been purchased by the household they can be included in that permit.
- Children are not required to have an adult with them when fishing.
- 64 years of age and older are not required to have a Johnstown fishing permit.
- No swimming or boating is allowed.
- Float tubes are allowed on the lake only while fishing.
- Alcoholic beverages and firearms are prohibited.
