Town of Johnstown 2020 Regular Municipal Election to Be Held April 7

Johnstown, Colo., February 3, 2020 – The Town of Johnstown will hold its Regular Municipal Election on Tuesday, April 7, 2020 by mail ballot. Ballots will be sent to the registered voters of Johnstown the week of March 16, 2020. For ballots to be counted in the election, they must be returned to the Town of Johnstown Town Clerk’s office by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, April 7, 2020.

The Mayor’s position and three (3) Councilmember positions are available for re-election on this year’s ballot. The only individual to qualify for election to the position of Mayor, which is a four-year term, is Gary Lebsack, who currently serves in that role. The individuals who qualify for election to the three Councilmember positions are Damien Berg, Troy Mellon and Chad Young. Each of them currently holds a seat on Town Council, and if re-elected, they will serve four-year terms.

As part of the election, registered Johnstown voters will also be asked to vote “Yes” or “No” on one ballot issue and two ballot questions, based on Resolutions adopted by Town Council during the January 22, 2020 regularly scheduled Town Council meeting. The following are ballot measures that will be included in the election:

- Ballot Issue 1A: To Approve a 0.5% Transportation Sales and Use Tax
- Ballot Question 1B: Amending the Town of Johnstown Home Rule Charter
- Ballot Question 1C: To Opt-Out of Senate Bill 152

To encourage informed voting in the upcoming Election, the Town has provided educational components to explain in detail each ballot measure.
